

Underground Miners Fundraiser

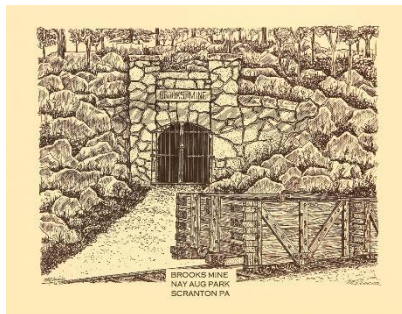
The UndergroundMiners.com is a local nonprofit volunteer organization dedicated to preserving and promoting anthracite coal mining heritage.

This group has just recently completed extensive restoration on the Brooks Mine at Nay Aug Park, Scranton and offers free guided tours in this unique replica of a working coal mine.

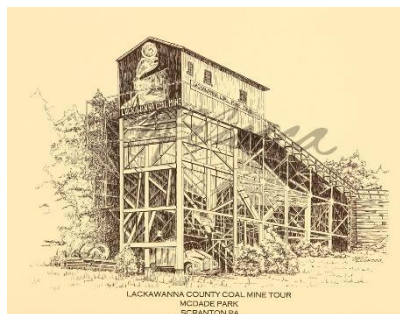
The 2024 schedule opens April 6 and runs every Saturday through Halloween. There will be some additional Sunday openings through July, August, and September.

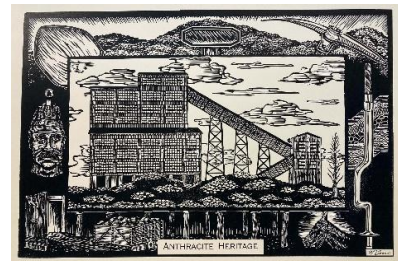
